SAN BERNARDINO JUDGES HONORED BY LOCAL ATTORNEYS' GROUP

SAN BERNARDINO, CA— Two San Bernardino judges were honored on Thursday, March 4, at virtual ceremony hosted by the Western San Bernardino County Bar Association at their 12th Annual Judicial Officer Awards Ceremony.

The Lifetime Achievement Award was presented to twenty-five year veteran, Supervising Judge Tara Reilly. This award honors a current or retired judge, commissioner or justice from San Bernardino County, Eastern Los Angeles County or Riverside County, who is recognized as having a reputation for and commitment to judicial excellence, achieved a significant length of service as a judicial officer, and has demonstrated a long-term, consistent and significant contribution to the betterment of the judiciary and the public it serves. Over the last twenty-five years, Supervising Judge Reilly has served in almost every judicial assignment including Probate, where she currently serves as Supervising Judge overseeing Probate, Conservatorship and Lanterman-Petris-Short Act cases.

The Judicial Officer of the Year Award was presented to Judge Bryan Foster, who has served since 2003. This award is an annual award which honors a current or retired judge, commissioner or justice from San Bernardino County, Eastern Los Angeles County or Riverside County, who has demonstrated long-term commitment to local, legal and judicial community, including significant work in upholding and providing impartial justice for all, improving the interaction between the judiciary and the bar, improving access for low and moderate income litigants, exhibiting appropriate judicial demeanor, and improving the efficiency and effectiveness of the court system. Judge Foster has been assigned to the civil division for the past nine years and served as the American Board of Trial Advocates Board President, along with presenting trial practice seminars and serving on multiple committees.
