## TENTATIVE RULINGS NOW AVAILABLE ONLINE

**SAN BERNARDINO, CA**—Pursuant to <u>Emergency Local Rule 8</u>, effective Tuesday, February 16, 2021, the San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) will begin posting tentative rulings for some law and motion matters on the court's website (See: <a href="https://www.sb-court.org/divisions/civil/civil-tentative-rulings">https://www.sb-court.org/divisions/civil/civil-tentative-rulings</a>.

A judicial officer <u>may</u> provide tentative rulings on law and motion matters after 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on the court's website the day before the scheduled hearing, or members of the public can call the assigned Administrative Assistant between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. (See: <u>Emergency Rules Related to COVID</u>).

You may appear in-person at the hearing, though remote appearance by CourtCall is preferred during the COVID-19 pandemic. (See <a href="www.sb-court.org/general-information/remote-access">www.sb-court.org/general-information/remote-access</a>).

If parties agree with the tentative ruling, they must notify opposing counsel/party and the department judicial assistant by 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the scheduled hearing. If all sides agree, the tentative ruling shall become the court's final ruling. The prevailing party shall give notice of the ruling, or prepare an Order if appropriate, per CRC 3.1312. Parties must appear at the hearing and/or address any issues outlined if directed to in the Court's tentative ruling even if both parties agree not to appear.
